## **WARNING!**

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS IN THIS GUIDE BEFORE ASSEMBLING OR USING YOUR VACUUM CLEANER. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, injury to persons or damage when using your vacuum cleaner, follow all safety precautions listed below.:

- Use your vacuum only as described in this Use & Care Guide. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not run the vacuum unattended.
- Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not vacuum, or use this vacuum near flammable liquids, gases, or explosive vapors like gasoline or other fuels, lighter fluids, cleaners, oil-based paints, natural gas, hydrogen, or explosive dust like coal dust, magnesium dust, grain dust, or gun powder. Sparks inside the motor can ignite flammable vapors or dust.
- To reduce the risk of health hazards from vapors or dust, do not vacuum toxic materials.
- Do not use or store near hazardous materials.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not pick up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws, coins, etc.
- Use only on dry, indoor surfaces.

- Do not expose to rain. Store indoors.
- If vacuum is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, immediately discontinue use and call 1-877-531-7321 (US) / 1-844-608-3081 (CA) for assistance.
- Do not allow your vacuum to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not unplug the charger by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not handle vacuum, charger, charger plug, stand charging base or charger terminal with wet hands.
- Do not charge the vacuum outdoors.
- To recharge vacuum, use only Chanzeho CZH013135065USWH or Chou Sen CS13A135065FUF charger.

#### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not incinerate the appliance even if it is severely damaged. The batteries can explode in a fire.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners.
- Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not use without filters in place.
- To reduce the risk of injury from accidental starting, ensure the power is OFF before changing or cleaning filter.
- Use extra care when cleaning stairs.
- Turn off the vacuum before connecting or disconnecting accessories.
- Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the power is OFF before picking up or carrying the vacuum. Carrying the vacuum with your finger on the power button can cause the vacuum to turn on and cause accidents.
- Keep the temperature range between 40°F (4°C) and 100°F (40°C) when charging battery, storing machine or during use.
- Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of fire when used with another battery pack.

- Under abusive conditions, liquid may be ejected from the battery; avoid contact. If contact accidentally occurs, flush with water. If liquid contacts eyes, additionally seek medical help. Liquid ejected from the battery may cause irritation or burns.
- Do not expose a vacuum to fire or excessive temperature. Exposure to fire or temperature above 265°F (130°C) may cause explosion.
- Follow all charging instructions and do not charge the vacuum outside of the temperature range specified in the instructions. Charging improperly or at temperatures outside of the specified range may damage the battery and increase the risk of fire.

- Do not modify or attempt to repair the vacuum except as indicated in the instructions for use and care.




#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

Before assembling the handheld vacuum, check the **PACKING LIST** (page 2). Use this list to verify that you have received all the components of your new Kenmore handheld vacuum.

1. Align the charging base with the tool attachment holder and press firmly to secure it in place.




2. Align the handheld vacuum with the charging base as illustrated and lock it into position. Verify that the dust cup is firmly attached.



3. Insert the upholstery tool and 2-in-1 combo tool onto the tool attachment holder.






#### CHARGING


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Before charging make sure the unit is turned OFF.

1. Plug the charger into the charging port on the side of the charging base as illustrated.



2. Insert the vacuum cleaner onto the support rails of the charging base. Ensure all connections are clean and free of dirt.




3. Connect the charger to a wall outlet. The LED indicator will flash red during the charging process. Once the battery is fully charged, the indicator will switch to a solid green light.

**NOTE:** Make sure the vacuum cleaner is fully charged before using for the first time. The vacuum may take up to about 4 hours to charge completely if fully discharged.

**NOTE:** Ensure that the vacuum cleaner faces down on the charging base and that it is securely docked. Make sure that there are no obstructions, such as debris or objects, that may interfere with the charging process.

4. When charging the vacuum, the battery status can be observed by looking at the LED indicators:

LED Indicator	Battery Status	Battery Capacity
2 LEDs	Green, Continuous	95%~100%
2 LEDs	Red, Flashing	50%~95%
1 LED	Red, Flashing	0~50%



#### CHARGING

**NOTE:** If the LED indicator does not illuminate when charging, ensure that:

• The vacuum cleaner is seated properly onto the charging base.

• The charging plug is plugged into the power supply properly.


• The electrical supply at the outlet is powered on.

• The charging connector is fully inserted in the charging base.


**NOTE:** For improved battery performance, always keep the vacuum cleaner on the charging base while not in use.

Never charge the vacuum cleaner in temperatures above 104°F (40°C) or below 39.2°F (4°C). It is normal for the charger to become warm when charging.


#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**



- 1. Make sure that the vacuum is in OFF position.
- 2. Your vacuum comes ready to clean.
- 3. Insert the 2-in-1 combo tool to the end of the nozzle until secured in place. The product can be used with the 2-in-1 combo tool to clean between tight spaces.




4. Press and hold the button on the back of the 2-in-1 combo tool and push towards the top of the tool until you hear a click and the brush head is in place. The product can be used to clean scratch-prone surfaces such as consoles or car vents.




#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

5. Insert the upholstery tool to the end of the nozzle until secured in place. Use the upholstery tool for cleaning fabric surfaces such as fabric sofa and bedsheets.



- 6. To turn on the vacuum, press the power button. The vacuum starts on the LOW speed setting. When functioning, only one LED will continuously illuminate a green light in low speed. When the battery runs low, the two LEDs will flash red.
- 7. To switch the speed to HIGH, press the speed setting button. When operating in high speed, both LEDs will display a steady green light. When the battery runs low, the two LEDs will flash red.



- 8. To turn off the vacuum, press the power button again.
- 9. When debris accumulates up to the MAX line of the dust cup, push the dust lid release button over a waste receptacle.



#### MAINTENANCE AND CARE

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To reduce the risk of an electric shock, remove the vacuum cleaner from the charging base, and ensure the machine is turned off before performing any maintenance.

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
Do not use alcohol, acetone, benzene, aggressive cleaning agents, etc., to clean the synthetic parts of the vacuum. Do not use hard brushes or metallic objects.

#### EMPTYING THE DUST CUP AND CLEANING THE FILTER


For best performance, empty dust cup after every use. Never operate the vacuum cleaner without dust cup and filter in place.

The filter is re-usable and should be cleaned regularly. For best performance, it is suggested to clean the filter after every use.


- 1. Verify that the vacuum is turned off.
- 2. Push the dust cup lid release button. Empty all debris and dust from the dust cup and then close the lid.



3. To remove the dust cup, press the release button and slide it off the support rail.



4. Remove the filter and filter holder by pulling the carrying handle.



#### EMPTYING THE DUST CUP AND CLEANING THE FILTER


**NOTE:** The key to maximum performance is having a clean filter. Cleaning the filter frequently will help your vacuum cleaner operate at peak efficiency. To purchase additional filters call 1-877-531-7321 (US) / 1-844-608-3081 (CA).

5. Rotate the filter counterclockwise. Pull the carrying handle and remove the filter from the filter holder. With a soft, dry brush, clean any accumulated debris from the side screens of the filter and the filter holder.




6. After repeated use, it may be necessary to wash the filter holder and filter. First brush loose debris from both basket and filter, then hand wash the basket and filter in warm water. After washing, set aside and allow to air dry for 24 hours.

**IMPORTANT:** The filter holder and filter must be completely dry before reuse. 7. Clean the vacuum housing using a damp cloth. Make sure no fluid enters the housing. Make sure the dust cup, the filter holder and reusable washable filter are clean and dry before using it again. DO NOT immerse the vacuum in water.




8. Insert the clean, dry filter into the filter holder and turn the carrying handle of the filter basket clockwise to lock it in place.




#### EMPTYING THE DUST CUP AND CLEANING THE FILTER

9. Align and insert the filter holder together with the filter into the dust cup.



10. Reconnect the dust cup to the hand vacuum. Push the dust cup into position along the support rail until you hear a 'click'.
